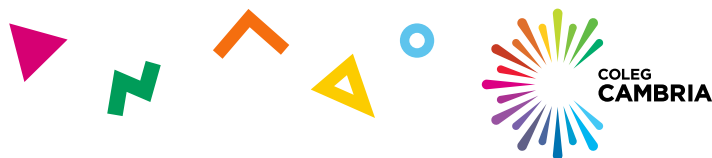

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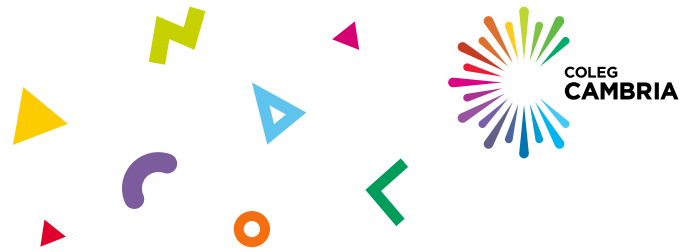
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# Principal's Welcome

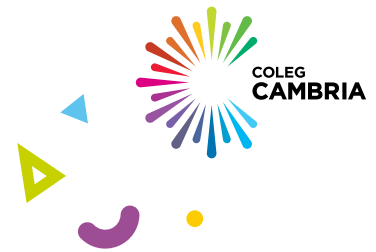

# Level 3 Learning



## Level 3 Learning

Level 3 courses give you access to university, higher or degree apprenticeships or skilled employment. Qualifications include A Levels, Vocational / Practical courses, Apprenticeships and Access to Higher Education courses.

## A Levels



These are two year academic programmes studied at either Deeside Sixth or Yale Sixth, with learners usually choosing a minimum of three and a maximum of four (if you achieve 5 or more A/A\*/7-9 grades at GCSE) A Level subjects. A Levels are typically assessed via exams. All A Level students will also enrol on to the Advanced Skills Baccalaureate qualification which will be studied as an additional A Level.

## Vocational / Practical Qualifications

These are mainly two year vocational qualifications, equivalent to studying three A Levels. These courses blend practical, career focused skills and academic study to prepare you for direct entry into employment, university or apprenticeships. Most of these courses have a work experience element attached to them. Vocational/Practical courses are typically assessed through coursework and observation of competency in practical skills. Most students taking a two year Level 3 vocational qualification will study the Advanced Skills Baccalaureate, although staff will clarify whether this applies to you during the application process.

## Apprenticeships



These work-based training programmes give you the skills, knowledge and competencies needed to progress in your chosen career. Apprentices work for an employer and earn a salary as well as studying alongside. Some apprentices are assessed at the workplace and others attend college one day per week.

## Access to Higher Education (HE)

Access to Higher Education courses are for people who left school without the usual qualifications and have gained substantial life experiences since leaving school. They prepare you to study for a degree after successful completion.

## Learn in Welsh

Cymraeg

If you have studied through the medium of Welsh or bilingually at school you can continue to do so at Coleg Cambria.

You can do the following in Welsh:

- Submit written work and receive bilingual notes
- Follow specific courses or modules
- Complete work experience in a range of Welsh speaking environments
- Assessments, entry interviews, tutorials, mentoring and meetings

If you have no Welsh language skills or would like to develop existing skills, there are also a great deal of opportunities for you to improve and gain confidence in using Welsh within your chosen subject area.

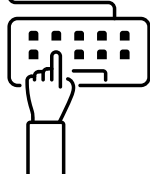
# How to Apply

## Decision of offer

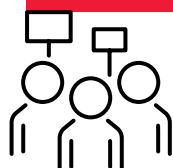
Once we have received your Stage 2 form, your application will be passed to the curriculum teams.

You will receive an email to confirm your place online on GCSE Results Day in August.

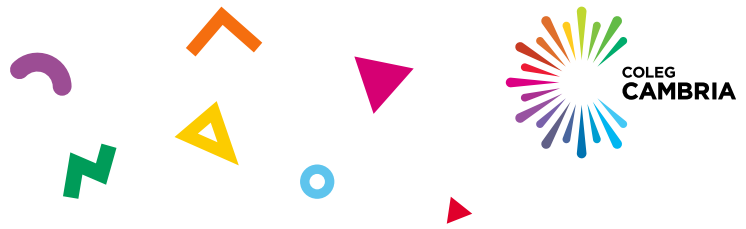

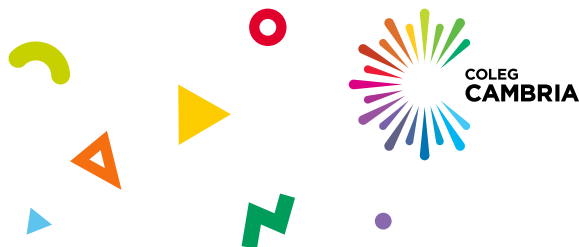

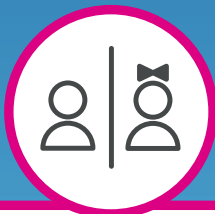

### Women's Football

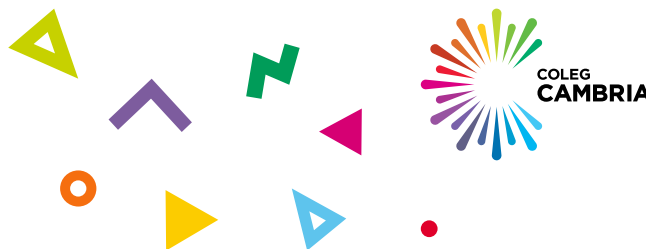

# English and Maths



**All learners who have not yet achieved a grade C or above in English or Maths are required to continue to study these subjects.**

This can either be done as a GCSE or an Essential Skills Wales (ESW) qualification.

We can help by offering you lessons and support sessions to make sure you have the support from tutors to improve your English and Maths skills.

If you do not have a GCSE grade C or above in English or Maths, you'll be contacted by your tutor after enrolment to discuss your next steps.

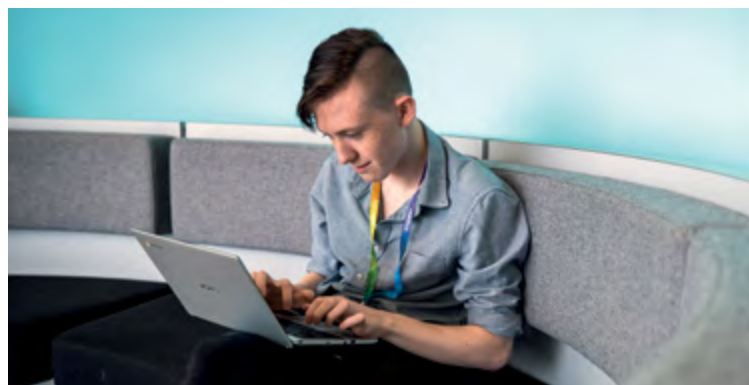
# Advanced Skills Baccalaureate Wales

**The Advanced Skills Baccalaureate Wales is an exciting new qualification for September 2023 and replaces the Advanced Skills Challenge Certificate that the College delivered successfully for many years.**

It encourages independence, adds real-life experience to the curriculum, develops additional personal interests and promotes skills highly regarded by universities and employers across the UK, such as critical thinking, problem solving, creativity and innovation.



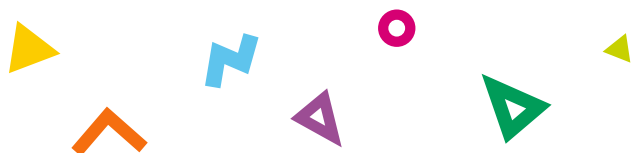
## What projects will I undertake?

The Advanced Skills Baccalaureate Wales is a 2 year programme that has the same UCAS points and grading structure as an A Level and can be combined with both A Level and Level 3 vocational programmes. You will undertake 3 projects during the 2 years, one based on sustainability, one focussing on your future plans and one completed individually on a subject of your choice.

## Who will study the Advanced Skills Baccalaureate Wales?

All A Level students will study the subject in addition to their other A Level subjects.

Most students taking a two year Level 3 vocational qualification will study the subject, although staff will clarify whether this applies to you during the application process.

# Apprenticeships



## What is an Apprenticeship?

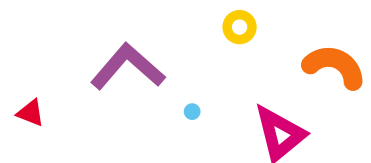

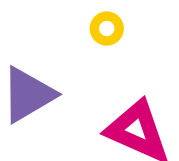

In addition you will receive a non-means tested training allowance, help towards travel costs and PPE needed for the workplace.

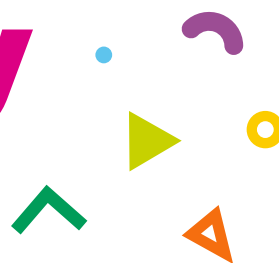

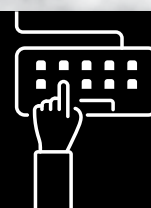

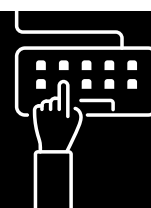

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# AS/A Level Art and Design (Art, Craft and Design)

CAN BE STUDIED AT :



**The course enables you to develop skills through a variety of activities and/or specialisms which could include textiles, drawing, painting, 3D and/or print making.**

You will use a wide range of media, techniques and approaches to produce a portfolio of art, craft and design work. There will be opportunities to work with practising artists, designers and craftspeople. You will participate in cultural and contextual activities and educational visits to support your studies.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs at grades A\* - C / 9 - 5 including English Language/Welsh (1st Language) and a grade A\* - B / 9 - 6 in an Art & Design related subject.

# AS/A Level Art and Design (Art, Craft and Design, Fine Art, Textile Design, 3D Design and Graphic Design)

CAN BE STUDIED AT :



**The course enables you to develop knowledge and practical skills to help you develop as a creative practitioner.**

You will explore a range of specialisms from textiles, drawing, painting, 3D, to print making. You will work with traditional art materials and also have the opportunity to use the latest digital media, using industry standard iMac computers, Adobe software and CAD. There will be opportunities to work with practising artists, designers and craftspeople.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs grade A\*-C / 9 - 5 including English Language/ Welsh (1st Language) and a grade A\*- B / 9 - 6 in any Art & Design endorsement (such as Fine Art, Graphic Communication, Textile Design, Three Dimensional Design or Photography).

\*Students cannot take more than one Art and Design endorsement.

# AS/A Level Art and Design (Photography: Interactive Media and Digital Communication)

CAN BE STUDIED AT :



**The course enables you to develop knowledge and practical skills to help you develop as a creative practitioner.**

You will use a wide range of media, techniques and approaches such as illustration, advertising, packaging design and communication and computer graphics to produce a portfolio of work. You can expect to work with traditional art materials and also the latest digital media using industry standard iMac computers, Adobe software and CAD.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs grade A\*-C / 9 - 5 including English Language/ Welsh (1st Language) and an Art & Design endorsement (such as Fine Art, Graphic Communication, Textile Design, Three Dimensional Design or Photography).

\*Students cannot take more than one Art and Design endorsement.



# AS/A Level Biology

CAN BE STUDIED AT :



**In AS/A Level Biology you will cover a wide range of topics including human body systems, evolution and biodiversity.**

You will also look at population growth, photosynthesis, respiration, food production and genetic inheritance. You will gain good laboratory experience through which you will develop your practical and writing skills. The AS Level areas of study include cell structure, cell division, adaptation for nutrition, transport in plants and animals. At A2, study extends to consider wider applications of Biology such as microbiology, homeostasis, inheritance and applications of genetics.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs at Grade A\* - C / 4/5 or above, including GCSE English or English Language/Welsh (1st Language). Applicants will also need grades BB / 66 in GCSE Science and Additional Science, or grade B / 6 in GCSE Biology. A grade B / 6 in GCSE Maths is also required. All Science qualifications must be achieved on Higher Tier papers.

# AS/A Level Business Studies

CAN BE STUDIED AT :

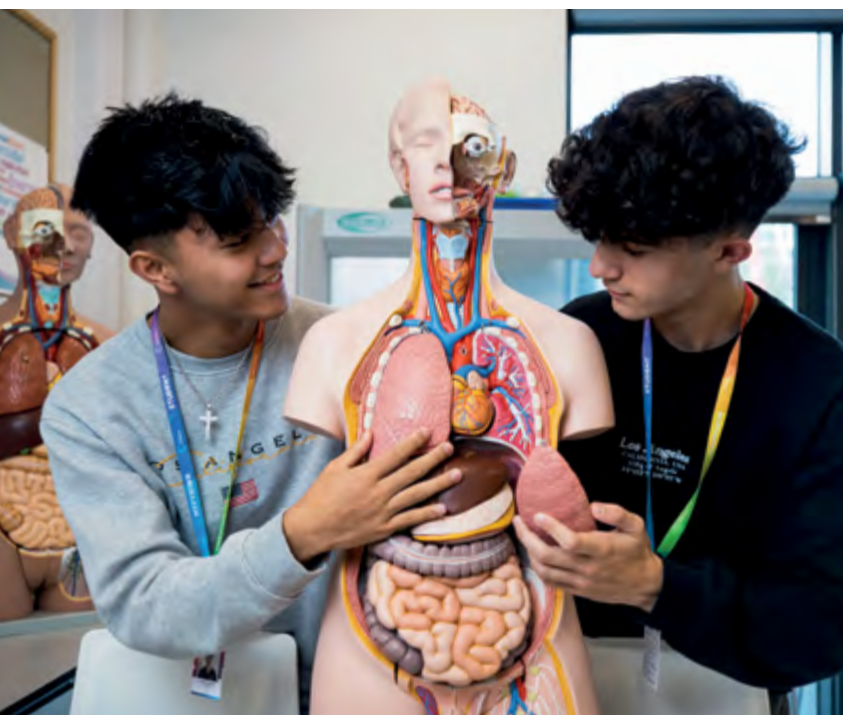


**The course will focus on the ever changing nature of business and how it is affected by national and international issues.**

At AS Level, students will study two modules. The first provides an introduction to the scope of Business Studies within the context of starting a new business. In the second module students examine how to measure the effectiveness of larger businesses, including marketing, finance, operations management and human resources. At A2 Level, students build on the theory introduced during the AS Level.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs at grade C / 4/5 or above, including English Language/Welsh (1st Language). Students will also require a C / 4/5 grade in either GCSE Maths or GCSE Numeracy, at Intermediate or Higher Tier.



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# AS/A Level Chemistry

CAN BE STUDIED AT :



**Chemistry is concerned with the study of materials, their properties, reactions and uses.**

Students enjoy learning through combined practical and theory work in which they experience working independently and as part of a group. Students gain important team and communication skills and the ability to reason logically on this course. They also develop planning, investigative, research and practical skills in the laboratory. These skill sets are highly valued by employers.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs at grade C / 4/5 or above, including GCSE English or English Language/Welsh (1st Language). Applicants will also need grades BB / 66 in GCSE Science and Additional Science or grade B / 6 in GCSE Chemistry, and grade B / 6 in GCSE Maths or Maths Numeracy. All Science qualifications must be achieved on Higher Tier papers.

# A Level Classical Civilisation

CAN BE STUDIED AT :



**Classical Civilisation is the study of ancient Greece and Rome through the history, literature and myth of these two civilisations.**

All students will study material from both Greece (year 1) and Rome (year 2) and their surrounding worlds, drawn from diverse time periods ranging from Archaic Greece to Imperial Rome. This study aims to give students a detailed understanding of this fascinating period in world history and an appreciation of its massive influence. During their study, students are encouraged to sharpen critical thinking and analytical skills in making sense of these events and personalities.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs at grade C / 4/5 or above, including GCSE English or English Language/Welsh (1st Language). No prior knowledge is necessary when choosing the subject at A Level.

# AS/A Level Computer Science

CAN BE STUDIED AT :



**This course, with its emphasis on data abstraction, general problem solving, algorithmic and mathematical reasoning, scientific and engineering based thinking, is a good foundation for understanding the future challenges in this increasingly technological age.**

You will develop an understanding of, and the ability to apply, the fundamental principles and concepts of Computer Science. You will gain the ability to analyse problems in computational terms through practical experience of solving such problems and develop the ability to articulate the individual (moral), social (ethical), legal and cultural opportunities and risks of digital technology.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs at grade C / 4/5 or above including English Language/Welsh (1st Language) and Mathematics or Maths Numeracy grade B / 6 or above. Some experience of programming would be advantageous, but this is not essential. However, if Computer Science was taken at GCSE, a C / 4/5 or above is required.

# AS/A Level Digital Technologies

**The course develops the capacity for thinking creatively, analytically, logically and critically.**

You will learn to apply skills, knowledge and understanding of Digital Technologies in a range of contexts to solve problems and gain an understanding of emerging technologies and the consequences of using Digital Technologies on individuals, organisations and society as well as social, legal, ethical and other considerations on the use of Digital Technologies.

You will learn transferrable skills needed such as co-operative working and project management.

# AS/A Level Drama and Theatre Studies

At AS you will understand and analyse live performances, study a set text and perform a scripted piece. At A2 you will study two texts, devise an original piece of drama and perform a scripted piece of theatre to a live audience. You will be required to attend professional theatre performances regularly.

# AS/A Level Economics

**During the two years of the programme students will cover topics including an introduction to economic principles, economics in action, exploring economic behaviour, and evaluating economic models.**

Delivery of the programme is varied and interesting, consisting of lectures, workshops, guest speakers, tutorials, trips and conferences.

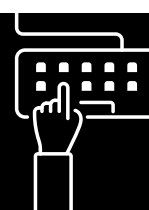

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# AS/A Level English Combined Language and Literature

**English Combined Language and Literature is an enjoyable, challenging and highly successful course at the College.**

As a student on this course you will learn to analyse and compare a wide variety of texts, from poetry, drama and novels to journalism and non-literary texts. You will acquire a detailed linguistic and literary vocabulary and knowledge of the contexts in which texts are written and received. The course also requires you to develop your writing skills: in fiction, in factual texts and in essays. Overall, the language skills developed at A Level are suitable for a huge variety of degree courses.

Applicants will also need grade B / 6 in Maths or Maths Numeracy, grades BB / 66 in Science and Additional Science or grade B / 6 in GCSE Physics (all Maths and Science qualifications must be attained on the Higher Tier paper). Grade A / 7 is required in Maths at GCSE if AS Maths is not being followed.

# AS/A Level Product Design

**Product Design offers a unique opportunity for you to identify and solve real problems by designing and making products in a wide range of contexts.**

Product Design develops your interdisciplinary skills and your capacity for imaginative, innovative thinking, creativity and independence. You will design and make products using a variety of skills and materials. You will develop and model your ideas then manufacture a prototype which can be tested and evaluated on completion. The design and manufacture of your products will entail using both hand and machine tools.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs grade A\*-C / 9-4 including Design & Technology at grade B / 6.

# AS/A Level Psychology

CAN BE STUDIED AT :



**Psychology is an exciting subject which attempts to understand how the mind works and to explain why individuals behave in certain ways.**

During AS Level you will study the following units; Psychology: Past to Present and Exploring and Investigating Behaviour. At A2 Level you will look at the following units; Implications in the Real World which includes, The Study of Behaviours, such as autistic spectrum behaviours, addictive behaviours, bullying behaviours, criminal behaviours, schizophrenia and stress, as well as Controversies. 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# Engineering - Fabrication and Welding



A huge part of mechanical engineering is fabrication and welding. Fabrication and welding allow for metal structures to be made into a range of shapes and sizes. It can be applied to a variety of industries such as engineering, construction, marine and more.

Fabrication of metal refers to the building of metal structures. This is done via a variety of processes including cutting, bending, profiling, welding and assembling. ## WELDING

Welding processes often include 'arc', which is a welding technique that uses a power supply in order to create an electric arc between the electrode on the welding rod and the material itself. The current created excels a huge amount of heat which is enough to melt the base material.
